

Peachtree Boulevard Pedestrian Enhancements

The CID is undertaking a two-phased initiative to improve safety and connectivity in response to sidewalk gaps along Peachtree Boulevard (SR-141). Phase 1 (3,000 linear feet) was completed in 2024 in collaboration with the City of Chamblee and GDOT. Phase 2 (6,700 linear feet) will be coordinated with DeKalb County's replacement of the main water line in 2026-2027.

Q3 2026 Update:

The project team submitted construction permits to GDOT. The CID is currently coordinating with the DeKalb County Watershed Department to deliver the project.
